## Policy Manual - Update

Broward Community College is organized as a multi-location community college under the general leadership and oversight of one President. A single catalog and a single set of policies and procedures govern operations on all locations.

**Collegewide Administrative Roles.** The Vice Presidents have collegewide responsibilities which are generally programmatic in nature. They recommend collegewide policies and procedures in their respective areas of responsibility after involving appropriate campus personnel in the development and consideration of those policies and procedures that will affect their operations.

**Campus-Based Administrative Roles.** The Provosts, the Executive Director of the Center for Health Sciences, and the Downtown Center Administrator are charged with implementing collegewide policies and procedures and have administrative responsibility for all activities taking place on the locations under their supervision.
