A student who meets the residence and other graduation requirements, except up to 6 credit hours of those required, may, upon transfer to another college and successful completion of the required hours at an accredited institution, submit a transcript and receive the associate degree from Broward Community College. Normally, the student must complete the requirements within one year after his/her last attendance at Broward Community College. In exceptional circumstances, the degree may be awarded to students who took longer than one year to complete the required hours.
