GENERAL STATEMENT

Broward College (the “College”) offers certification services to assist veterans and/or their dependents with applying for Veterans educational benefits.

THE POLICY AND THE STUDENT

The College provides services such as career counseling, advising, and certification to students including students who are receiving Veterans educational benefits. Veterans and dependents of veterans may access services through the Student Financial Services Department.

IMPLEMENTATION AND OVERSIGHT

The Associate Vice President for Student Success and Enrollment Management Services, under the direction of the Vice President for Student Affairs and Enrollment Management is responsible for the implementation and oversight of policy compliance. Students who wish to grieve a decision related to the determination of veteran benefits may appeal to the Veterans Administration Office (1-888-GIBILL1). In the event the veteran or dependent fails to meet satisfactory academic progress, the student may appeal to the College’s Veterans Coordinator after one term has elapsed.

VIOLATION OF POLICY

Students who are veterans who fail to follow the guidelines set forth by the US Department of Veterans Administration may have their GI benefits delayed or denied.

DEFINITIONS

Veteran – a person who served in the United States active military, naval, or air service, and who was discharged or released therefrom under conditions other than dishonorable.
