GENERAL STATEMENT

Broward College (the “College”) encourages student organizations to seek outside sources of funding for their activities in a manner that supports the overall operation of the College. Student organization fundraising activities must have a positive impact on students and the College community and must be consistent with the overall fundraising operations of the College.

THE POLICY AND THE STUDENT

Student organizations must seek prior permission from the director/coordinator of student life on the campus or center prior to engaging in fundraising activities. Funds raised must be deposited into a College Agency Account in accordance with BC Policy 6Hx2-6.25.

IMPLEMENTATION AND OVERSIGHT

The director/coordinator of student life on the campus or center, under the direction of the appropriate chief student affair officer on the campus or center, and in consultation with the Executive Director of the BC Foundation is responsible for implementation and oversight of policy compliance. Student organizations who wish to grieve a decision of the student life director/coordinator may appeal in writing to the appropriate chief student affairs officer on the campus/center within 5 days of the decision. The chief student affairs officer, in consultation with the Associate Vice President for Student Development Services will consider the appeal and render a decision within 5 business days after receiving the request from the student. If the student is not satisfied with the response of the chief student affairs officer, he/she may appeal in writing to the Vice President for Student Affairs and Enrollment Management within 5 business days after the decision is rendered by the student dean. The Vice President for Student Affairs and Enrollment Management, in consultation with the Campus Provost, will render a decision within 5 business days after receiving the request from the student. The decision of the Vice President for Student Affairs and Enrollment Management shall be final.

VIOLATION OF THE POLICY

The College may cancel the fundraising event if prior approval is not granted. The College may further cancel any affiliation with an outside vendor if it deemed that such a relationship is in conflict with the mission, philosophy, purpose, or College Policy. Individual students and student organizations who violate this policy are subject to discipline through the College Student Code of Conduct.

DEFINITIONS

Student organization – a student organization registered with a College campus student life office.
