GENERAL STATEMENT

All Broward College (the “College”) students enrolled in degree and certificate programs must obtain and carry a College Identification Card. The first issuance of a College Identification Card is free of charge for students. Students will be charged a fee for replacement cards in accordance with BC Procedure A6Hx2-5.24.

The College Identification Card is primarily used for identification, for verification of enrollment status, and for using on-campus College services such as the University/College Library and gaining access to various College facilities. The College Identification Card may be obtained in the Student Life area of each campus/center.

Students enrolled in fully on-line programs shall be provided with access to University/College Library services in a manner that supports on-line learning.

THE POLICY AND THE STUDENT

All students enrolled in degree and certificate programs at a College campus, or any student wishing to access services at any College location, are required to carry a College Identification Card.

IMPLEMENTATION AND OVERSIGHT

The Associate Vice President for Student Development Services, under the supervision of the Vice President for Student Affairs and Enrollment Management, is responsible for the implementation of the College Identification Card program.

VIOLATION OF POLICY

Students who attempt to obtain a College Identification Card under false pretenses or who fail to show a College Identification Card when requested by an appropriate member of the College faculty or staff, may be denied access to College facilities or services, and are subject to discipline through the BCC Student Code of Conduct.

DEFINITIONS

Identification Card – the official card used for College Identification.
