<b>Title:</b> Fundraising by Student Groups and Organizations	<b>Number:</b> 6Hx2-5.21

With prior permission from the campus provost/center director and the chief student affairs officer of the campus/center, student clubs and organizations may conduct fundraising events or activities to support club activities or approved projects. The campus/center approving administrator will seek approval from the Vice President for Development for fundraising events beyond the level of bake sales and car washes before authoring the student organization to proceed. Student clubs and organizations may invite an outside fundraising entity to assist in their student fundraising initiatives. When they do, the outside entity shall be identified in the fundraising proposal that is submitted for approval. In such a proposal, the specific amount of money from the fundraising entity to the students shall be clearly stated. In addition, the products or services offered by a vendor in support of a fundraising effort must have a positive impact on students, support the quest for academic success, and be consistent with the College mission.
