House Bill 1545/Senate Bill 1794 amends sections 239.301, 240.117, and 240.124 of the *Florida Statutes* relating to the fees assessed students enrolled more than twice in college preparatory instruction. The Senate Bill requires that effective Fall, 1999, a student enrolled in the same college-preparatory class within a skill area more than twice or a student enrolled in college-credit courses for a third time shall pay fees at 100 percent of the full cost of instruction and shall not be included in calculations of full-time equivalent enrollments for state funding purposes unless the student is granted an exception due to extenuating circumstances and/or financial hardship.

The President is authorized to issue implementing procedures to waive the 100 percent fee requirement one time for each course based on extenuating circumstances and to waive the additional matriculation fees for continued enrollment in a college preparatory or college-credit class contingent upon a student's financial hardship in accordance with guidelines promulgated by the Division of Community Colleges.

The President is further authorized to issue implementing procedures to notify students about instructional programs that provide students with alternatives to traditional college preparatory instruction, including private provider instruction.
