The Vice President for Facilities and College Services is authorized to establish a comprehensive program of safety and sanitation for the protection of all persons. This comprehensive program shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- The implementation and evaluation of a comprehensive safety plan in accordance with the *Criteria for Accreditation* of the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools
- The adequate provision and use of safety equipment in laboratories and other hazardous areas
- The display of emergency evacuation procedures for all buildings
- Compliance with the provisions of the Florida Right-to-Know for Hazardous Materials
- Compliance with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration’s rule on occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens
- Compliance with Rule 10D-104, Florida Administrative Code, Biomedical Waste

Periodic safety and sanitation inspections shall be conducted at least once during each fiscal year with a copy of the inspection report forwarded to the Department of Education and the State Fire Marshal. If major deficiencies are noted in any inspection, the Board of Trustees shall be notified of plans to alleviate the deficiency.
