GENERAL STATEMENT of the policy

The District Board of Trustees of Broward Community recognizes and accepts the duties and powers of the Community College District Board of Trustees as prescribed in Florida Statute 1001.64 and rules of the State Board of Education. The District Board of Trustees is vested with the responsibility to operate Broward Community College (the College) with such necessary authority as is needed for the proper operation and improvement in accordance with rules of the State Board of Education and the Florida Board of Education.

The District Board of Trustees is specifically authorized by Florida law to adopt rules, procedures, and policies, consistent with law and rules of the State Board of Education related to its mission and responsibilities as set forth in law with regards to its governance, personnel, budget and finance, administration, programs, curriculum and instruction, buildings and grounds, travel and purchasing, technology, students, contracts and grants, or college property. These rules may supplement those prescribed by the State Board of Education and the Florida Board of Education if they contribute to the more orderly and efficient operation of the Florida Community College System.

THE POLICY and THE FACULTY AND STAFF

The College is required to provide high quality and affordable education and training opportunities with an open admission policy to serve all who might benefit, without discrimination.

Its mission and responsibility is to respond to community needs for postsecondary academic and career degree education by providing lower level undergraduate instruction and awarding associate degrees; preparing student for careers requiring baccalaureate degrees or less, providing student development services; promoting economic development for Broward County; and providing dual enrollment instruction to qualified high school students.

THE POLICY and THE FACULTY AND STAFF

The College is required by Florida Statutes 1001.64(18) to establish personnel programs for all employees of the community college, including the president, pursuant to the provisions of Fla. Chapter 1012 and Rules and Guidelines of the State Board of Education.

IMPLEMENTATION and OVERSIGHT

The President as the chief executive officer of the community college is responsible for the operation and administration of the college. All components of the institution and all aspects of its operation are responsible to the Board of Trustees through the President.
