The Aviation Institute at BCC South Campus is in possession of an F104 Jet Engine that was donated by the Florida Dept. of Management Services Bureau of Federal Property Assistance. The Museum of Discovery and Science (MDS) in Ft. Lauderdale, which is opening an aviation exhibit, would like to obtain this engine and display it as part of their permanent exhibit. The display will indicate that the item "is donated by Broward Community College."

Donating this item to MDS will not in any way affect student learning at the Aviation Institute because it is seldom used in instruction. The F104 Engine has no immediate cash value and its effect can be easily duplicated by the remaining engines we are in possession of. By making this donation and by exhibiting it to nearly half a million visitors every year, we will significantly expand the exposure of BCC's aviation program to our local community.

This recommendation is closely aligned with Goal 4 of the Educational Master Plan by positioning BCC as the preferred choice of workforce training in Broward County. It also contributes to the strengthening of BCC's image in our community.

Request permission to donate a F401 Jet Engine, S/N 960007A, to The Museum of Discovery & Science located at 401 SW 2nd Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33312.

Issue:

The Museum of Discovery and Science (MDS) in Ft. Lauderdale, which is opening an aviation exhibit, has expressed an interest in an F104 engine that was previously donated to BCC by the Florida Department of Management Services Bureau of Federal Property Assistance (FDMSBFPA). The FDMSBFPA has transferred title of this engine to BCC and consents to the third-party transfer.


Background/Analysis:


The MDS is a not-for-profit organization. It serves 500,000 visitors each year, and it offers educational programs and workshops to students. By donating this engine to the Museum, it would help further expose BCC's aviation program to our community.

Fiscal Impact:

Given the condition it is in, the F104 Engine has no immediate cash value on the market. Because it is seldom used in instruction and its effect can be easily duplicated on the remaining engines we possess, the Institute can relinquish possession of this engine without affecting the quality of instruction in our Airframe & Powerplant Certification programs.

The Museum of Discovery & Science will provide for pick-up and delivery of the said engine. The engine stand in which the engine is mounted will be returned to BCC Aviation Institute once a suitable alternative mode of mounting has been established but not to exceed six months from the date of delivery.

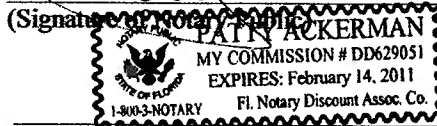

Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is in response to your request for a copy of your organization's determination letter. This letter will take the place of the copy you requested.

Our records indicate that a determination letter issued in March 1979 granted your organization exemption from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. That letter is still in effect.

Based on information subsequently submitted, we classified your organization as one that is not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code because it is an organization described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi).

This classification was based on the assumption that your organization's operations would continue as stated in the application. If your organization's sources of support, or its character, method of operations, or purposes have changed, please let us know so we can consider the effect of the change on the exempt status and foundation status of your organization.

Your organization is required to file Form 990, Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax, only if its gross receipts each year are normally more than \$25,000. If a return is required, it must be filed by the 15th day of the fifth month after the end of the organization's annual accounting period. The law imposes a penalty of \$20 a day, up to a maximum of \$10,000, when a return is filed late, unless there is reasonable cause for the delay.

All exempt organizations (unless specifically excluded) are liable for taxes under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (social security taxes) on remuneration of \$100 or more paid to each employee during a calendar year. Your organization is not liable for the tax imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA).

Organizations that are not private foundations are not subject to the excise taxes under Chapter 42 of the Code. However, these organizations are not automatically exempt from other federal excise taxes.

Donors may deduct contributions to your organization as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to your organization or for its use are deductible for federal estate and tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of sections 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.

Your organization is not required to file federal income tax returns unless it is subject to the tax on unrelated business income under section 511 of the Code. If your organization is subject to this tax, it must file an income tax return on the Form 990-T, Exempt Organization Business Income Tax Return. In this letter, we are not determining whether any of your organization's present or proposed activities are unrelated trade or business as defined in section 513 of the Code.


The law requires you to make your organization's annual return available for public inspection without charge for three years after the due date of the return. If your organization had a copy of its application for recognition of exemption on July 15, 1987, it is also required to make available for public inspection a copy of the exemption application, any supporting documents and the exemption letter to any individual who requests such documents in person or in writing. You can charge only a reasonable fee for reproduction and actual postage costs for the copied materials. The law does not require you to provide copies of public inspection documents that are widely available, such as by posting them on the Internet (World Wide Web). You may be liable for a penalty of \$20 a day for each day you do not make these documents available for public inspection (up to a maximum of \$10,000 in the case of an annual return).

Because this letter could help resolve any questions about your organization's exempt status and foundation status, you should keep it with the organization's permanent records.

**Museum of Discovery & Science
Aviation Exhibit Description**

DC-9 Cockpit. The visitor will be able to sit at the controls in the DC9 cockpit and experience what it might be like to be a pilot. The visitor will learn how the pilot would use the information displayed on the illuminated instruments to monitor the aircraft. They will also hear some Air Traffic Controller / Pilot chatter.

Lear Jet tail section static display.

Pitch, Yaw, Roll an interactive exhibit showing the effect of different control surfaces.

Materials the visitor can learn about the different materials used to build an aircraft.

A Regional Jet cabin mid section that will give the visitors a view of the inside of an aircraft cabin.

A 15ft tall mock ATC tower. My intent with the ATC exhibit is to briefly illustrate to the general public how the massive number of aircraft flying on a typical day get from point A to point B safely. The ATC tower will contain four LCD monitors. Monitor #1 will be the starting place. The visitor will press a button, a Miami based ATC controller will give a brief taped overview of the ATC system and explain what information is being shown on the other three LCD monitors. Monitor #2 will show a time laps (Aircraft Situation Network) video of air traffic as it builds during a typical day. This monitor is intended to show the massive numbers of aircraft. The tower will have an excessed controller work station incorporated into its base and display a 20 minute video loop of air traffic with controller / pilot chatter from 20 miles out. I video taped a STARS display in the Miami ATC lab. Monitor #4 will have a video loop showing aircraft landing and taxing to the gate, sort of the end of the story. I think it is called TAMS.

A Bernoulli demonstration. The visitor will learn how the unique shape of an airfoil causes low pressure on the top of an aircraft wing, which increases lift. The visitor will change the angle of attack of a clear plexiglas airfoil against a stream of passing air and see 4 ping pong ball rise to the top of the airfoil because of low pressure.

A Fiberglass Cockpit Simulator that will give the visitor the opportunity to fly either the F/22 Raptor or the FA/18 Blue Angles version.

A smaller ATC kiosk houses three additional aircraft simulators.

* DC 9

* Cessna 172 Sky hawk

* Airbus A380

Airbus A380 mural. There will be a 20 foot wide wall mural illustration of the new Airbus A380 aircraft drawn by flight international. The detailed illustration shows the airframe and identifies some of the materials used in the construction of the aircraft.

Ft Lauderdale International Airport Mural. This is a 17 foot wide by 15 foot tall aerial view of Ft Lauderdale airport and its runway system. The visitor will learn about runway numbers, runway markings and how the weather effect which runway is used. There will be a radio scanner tuned to some of the frequencies used at the airport. There will be a weather station and the visitor will see how wind speed and direction determines which runway is used that day.

Runway the visitor can walk on a 65' long simulated runway and learn about the different markings and what information they give the pilot.
