Subject: Agenda Item VI-C - Naming in Honor of Doris L. Sams

**Brief Description:**

Pursuant to the Will of Dorothy A. Cusick, on December 22, 1999 a bequest in the amount of \$175,000 was left to the Broward Community College Foundation to honor Doris L. Sams, a former long-time BCC employee. Ms. Sams was an advisement counselor on South Campus from 1966 until her death in 1995. The bequest was used to help complete the construction of the South Campus Performing and Cultural Arts Center facility. On June 1, 2001, in a letter from Judy Bowen, former Executive Director of the BCC Foundation (see attached), the commitment to name the Audience Chamber of the South Campus Performing Arts Center was made in recognition of the gift. We are hereby requesting to name the Audience Chamber at the South Campus Performing and Cultural Arts Center for Doris L. Sams to comply with the terms of the agreement.

**Benefit to BCC:**

The bequest enabled Broward Community College to build the Performing and Cultural Arts Center facility on South Campus, which is helping to enrich the cultural and artistic offerings for our students and the surrounding community.

**Relation to the College Master Plan and Priorities:**

The naming of the South Campus Performing and Cultural Arts Center Audience Chamber supports Goal #5 of the College's Education Master Plan and its specific object of seeking new revenue sources.
