Brief Description:

In 2006, the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission mandated a six hour Dart-Firing Stun Gun course as part of the 770 hour Basic Recruit Training Curriculum. To uphold this mandate, training centers are required to supply tasers to students for this course. The City of Coral Springs Police Department would like to donate 85 tasers to the Institute of Public Safety. This donation saves the Institute of Public Safety and Broward College thousands of dollars as the estimated value is \$25,500.

Acceptance of these donated items will assist the institute of Public Safety to meet the goals which position Broward College as the vehicle of choice for training Broward's law enforcement officers.


