GENERAL STATEMENT

In accordance with Florida Statute 1001.64(8), the Board of Trustees has the authority for policies related to student financial assistance. The President is authorized to establish the procedures necessary to assure compliance with the applicable laws and rules stated in the State Board of Education Administrative Rule 6A-20.002 relative to accounting for and disbursing funds designated for student financial aid.

THE POLICY and THE STUDENT

Student assistance, as awarded by the Office of Student Financial Services in accordance with Policy 6Hx2-5.11, will be accounted for and disbursed to students as required by State Board of Education Administrative Rule 6A-20.002.

THE POLICY and THE FACULTY AND STAFF

Faculty and staff are required to comply with applicable Federal, State and College rules relative to accounting for and disbursing funds designated for student financial aid.

IMPLEMENTATION and OVERSIGHT

The Chief Financial Officer has responsibility for the implementation and oversight of this policy, including the investigation of any alleged policy violations.

VIOLATION OF POLICY

Violations of this policy shall be investigated by the Chief Financial Officer with assistance from the Vice President for Human Resources and Equity to determine the appropriate course of disciplinary action, up to and including termination.
