GENERAL STATEMENT

The use or sale of alcoholic beverages at all Broward Community College sites are is prohibited.

Under carefully controlled conditions, the use or sale of alcoholic beverages may be permitted on special occasions as an exception to the normal prohibition. Requests for permission to use or sell alcohol at a particular campus event must be submitted in writing to the President, who will grant or deny permission in writing.

At an event where College facilities may be rented and/or when a rental fee is waived, at the request of the renter or user, a request in writing may be submitted to the President of the College, for permission to serve or sell alcoholic beverages, and the President will grant or deny permission in writing.

There are no exceptions to this policy.

THE POLICY and THE STUDENT.

This policy is intended to give all students an environment that is conducive to excellent learning outcomes along with enhancing safety conditions.

THE POLICY and THE FACULTY AND STAFF.

This policy, along with the College drug free policy, is intended to provide safe working conditions while providing an environment conducive to excellent learning outcomes.

IMPLEMENTATION and OVERSIGHT.

The VP Facilities has responsibility for the implementation and oversight of this policy, including the investigation of any alleged policy violations.

VIOLATION OF POLICY.

All individuals in violation of these established policies may be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including termination.
