Brief Description:

The Wheelchair Foundation has donated two, new manual wheelchairs to Broward College to benefit students and staff with temporary physical impairments.

Benefit to BC:

Broward College serves approximately 600 students with disabilities each year. This number does not include the hundreds of students or staff members who might have a temporary physical impairment that requires the use of a wheelchair on a temporary basis. Having wheelchairs available on campus on an "as needed basis" is going to be a plus for the Disability Services department. The chairs will be used if someone's electric wheelchair breaks down, someone falls, or someone needs emergency assistance to get from building to building/class to class.
