## GENERAL STATEMENT

In accordance with the Florida Clean Air Act, the President shall establish procedures necessary to prohibit smoking in College facilities. Individuals in violation of these procedures may be subject to disciplinary action. Campus Provosts have the responsibility for establishing designated smoking areas on their respective campus.

## THE POLICY and THE STUDENT.

To ensure that all students are able to learn in a safe, healthy smoke-free environment.

## THE POLICY and THE FACULTY AND STAFF.

To ensure that all Faculty and Staff can work in a safe, healthy, smoke-free environment.

## IMPLEMENTATION and OVERSIGHT.

The President has the authority to establish procedures to implement this policy with Board of Trustees approval. The VP Facilities and Campus Provosts have the responsibility for the implementation and oversight of this policy, including the investigation of any alleged policy violations.

## VIOLATION OF POLICY.

All individuals in violation of these established policies may be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including termination.
