

TERM SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This application is for full-time and part-time term scholarships from the Honors Institute. Award amounts vary each term and are based on merit. Criteria is outlined below.

FULL-TIME SCHOLARSHIP

- Applicant must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours during the award term
- Applicant must be enrolled in at least one Honors class (3 credits)

Scholarships are funded by the generous contributions of the Broward College Foundation donors, which include the Burkhard and Rasmuson funds; F. Louis and May Jean Wolff; Barbara Evertz Foundation; and the Honors Institute.

PART-TIME SCHOLARSHIP

- Applicant must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours during the award term
- Applicant must be enrolled in at least one Honors class (3 credits)

Scholarships are funded by the generous contributions of Mr. Robert L. Elmore, who established the Robert "Bob" Elmore Honors Institute Scholarship Endowment.

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS:

- Applicants are required to write a thank you letter to the donor prior to disbursement of funds
- Applicant must be a member of the Honors Institute with a minimum 3.50 Overall/Honors GPA. The GPA is calculated using college-level credits, including transfer credits. Transfer GPA's may deem some applicants ineligible
- Applicants must be Florida residents for tuition purposes
- Applicants must file a FAFSA (excepting international students) and have a complete financial aid file
- Applicants receiving the maximum financial aid award for the calendar year may be ineligible. Consult with Financial Aid if you are already receiving numerous grants or scholarships
- "Irm's 100" and dual enrolled students are not eligible
- F1 student eligibility depends on available funds

DISTRIBUTION:

Scholarship amounts vary each term and are determined by available funding and number of applicants.

Applicants will be notified via Broward College e-mail at least two weeks after the scholarship application deadline.
