Effective Winter Term (2013) for Qualified Students



The Army Senior ROTC Basic Course is a prerequisite for all unqualified students pursuing a Bachelors degree and desiring to enter the Senior Army ROTC program as a college junior. The Basic Course is comprised of four courses, Military Science and Leadership (MSL) 1101, MSL 1102, MSL 2101, and MSL 2102. The Basic Course is designed to introduce cadets to the fundamentals of leadership and to prepare them for success in the Army ROTC Advanced Course. The content and methods of the Basic Course assume no prior Cadet experience or other military training. The ROTC Basic Course consists of two distinct components: The classroom introduction to the Army and Officership of the MSL I year and the experiential examination of leadership, group process, and decision-making of the MSL II year. Both Basic Course years are designed to enhance the Cadets' interest in ROTC and the Army.

ENROLLMENT

Students will be required to enroll in the correct course based on their actual Broward College classification, i.e., freshman or sophomore, and projected date of graduation.

*****NOTE: Sophomore students are still required to complete freshman level Army ROTC courses; if this is not possible please consult with the Army ROTC Instructor!**

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED COURSES

Once a student completes all Basic Course requirements they are eligible to enter the Advanced Course. The following upper level courses are required to obtain a commission as an Army Officer.
