- ❖ SACS guidelines allow BCC to train individuals with Masters degrees in any discipline and a demonstrated interest in student success so they may qualify to teach our SLS courses.
- ❖ To that end, the college has created a 12-hour SLS Instructor Training Program to give more faculty, staff and administrators an opportunity to become eligible to teach an SLS course.
