The requirements for reporting include two elements. First; a report must be made available to students, prospective students, and the public by October $15^{\text {th }}$ of each year. Second; the data must be reported online within 15 days of making it available to the public. The data is submitted online to the Secretary of Education after which it is migrated to the Office of PostSecondary Education (OPE) public website at http://ope.ed.gov/athletics.

This report is made available to fulfill the first element of making the data available publicly. It contains elements which are in addition to those required by the online report submission. You are encouraged to visit the OPE public site after October $30^{\text {th }}$ to view the online support.
