ASSOCIATE DEGREE IN AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY

1. Submit or mail the Corporate Automotive Technology Program Application to any of the corporate program coordinators or if applying for multiple programs mail to **BCC Automotive Program Director, 7451 Riviera Blvd., Miramar, FL 33023.**
2. Complete a Broward Community College **APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION** form (available from BCC and the Coordinators) and return it along with proof of one year Florida residence to the Registrar's office at any BCC campus with a NON-Refundable \$35.00 Application Fee (all first time BCC applicants).
3. Attend BCC orientation and take the Computerized Placement Test (CPT) at Broward Community College (preferably South Campus). Information about test dates and times are available when you submit the College Application form to the registrar or you can call (954) 201-8884 for the weekly orientation/CPT test schedule. You will not be required to take this test if you can present evidence of having completed a college course in Algebra and English Composition (**transcript required**) or can present scores for an ACT or SAT test, taken within the last 2 years, to the BCC South Campus Advisement Office.
4. Meet with the Automotive Academic Advisor to review your test results, or transcript. No appointment is required, (954) 201-8611. Hours are Monday through Friday 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.
