

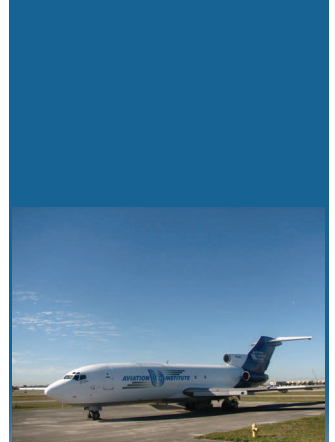
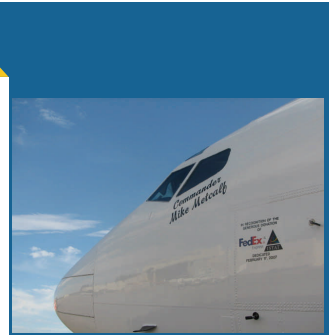


Aviation unveils Boeing 727

The Aviation Institute at Broward Community College (BCC) is proud to announce the unveiling of its newly painted Boeing 727 aircraft donated by FedEx in 2004. The aircraft is being used to teach and train students enrolled in BCC's aviation maintenance and avionics programs. The aviation maintenance technician program is a FAA certified program and has an enrollment of more than 100 students annually. It prepares students to start a career as an FAA certified aircraft maintenance technician or FCC avionics technician.

The Boeing 727 donation was facilitated by the International Society of Transport Aircraft Trading (ISTAT) thanks to the outstanding support of its member Michael Metcalf. The airplane will be unveiled on Saturday, February 17 at the annual "Wings, Wheels and Waves" event at the Aviation Institute, BCC South Campus.
