

BCC's Aviation Institute: A direct path to the aviation field and the airlines

Have you always wanted to fly or become an airline pilot? Are you fascinated by planes and how they work? Would you be interested in learning how the airports operate and love to be a part of it? If you're thinking of getting into the aviation field and broaden your career opportunities, Broward Community College's Aviation Institute has the career path for you. In only 2 years you can obtain an Associate in Science degree and become a professional pilot, an aviation maintenance technician or an aviation/ airport operations professional.



The Associate in Science degree in professional pilot technology is designed for students who want to become pilots and have a career in the aviation field. All flight certificates are included in the curriculum, and after two years, the student finishes with a college degree along with all ratings needed to work in the field as a commercial pilot. It is a program offered in partnership with Delta Connection Academy (DCA), an industry leader with a long history of success.



In our airline oriented environment the student is guaranteed an interview with the regional airlines once he / she has built up enough hours of training. And in the past year, 97 % of our graduated instructors have been hired.

The aviation maintenance technology program gives the student the confidence to become a highly qualified technician in the competitive marketplace of aviation maintenance. In only 20 months, BCC's innovative program will train the student for both FAA **Airframe** and FAA **Powerplant (A & P)** certificates.



An **Avionics** certificate is also available for those students who want to specialize and work in the electronics of the airplane. Aircraft mechanics are responsible for keeping the nation's airplanes flying, and they are among the best paid jobs in the industry. Forbes magazine recently qualified it as the # 6 in the top ten paying blue collar careers.



Our maintenance program also offers a great apprenticeship program where our students get hands on experience in some of the best companies in the area and 96 % of our students get employed even before they finish our courses.



Airport operations management and aviation operations are two degrees designed for individuals whose career objectives include a wide variety of staff, operational, management or administrative positions in the aviation field. Students can practice real world experience and the day-to-day activities in the field while learning the certification requirements of international airports. BCC has an outstanding internship program with Fort Lauderdale/ Hollywood International Airport and Miami International Airport. Many of most of our

interns have been placed after completing their internships.



Furthermore, all of our Associate in Science degrees are transferable to Florida Atlantic University (FAU) towards a Bachelor in Business Administration and to Embry-Riddle University extended campuses (Miami and Fort Lauderdale) towards a variety of bachelor's degrees.
