



Experiential Learning Credits for FAA Certificates/Ratings and Professional Experience Policy

- You must first apply and be accepted to Broward College and complete at least one Broward College course successfully before completing this request for credits.
- Carefully complete the attached application. *Incomplete applications will be returned.* Answer all questions and sign.
- Copy all FAA certificates (front and back), and a copy a Government issued photo I.D.
- If you are joining the Professional Pilot Technology Degree Program with existing FAA certificates or ratings, you are eligible to receive experiential credit upon completion of the next higher level flight course offered by the college through this application process. Students not doing flight training at Broward College should select program major code 2105 for credits towards the Aviation Operations Degree.
- If you have been employed as a professional pilot for more than a year, you are eligible for credits towards the professional pilot technology degree. Please include a letter from your employer verifying employment and a job description for your position with the company. If you have documentation of flight currency, please include this with your packet. A copy of the last 5 (five) pages of your log book will be required. If you have taken courses at Broward College, include a transcript and program sheet checking any completed courses.

Note: Some courses may require department testing in order to receive credit. Testing must be completed within the same semester in which you are making this application. If testing is required, you will be notified and will be required to pay a fee to the cashier located in building 68 on south campus.

Once all requirements have been met, credits will appear by the end of the semester on your transcript if at least (4) four weeks remain in the term in which you apply for experiential credits. You may check your transcript online at: www.broward.edu
