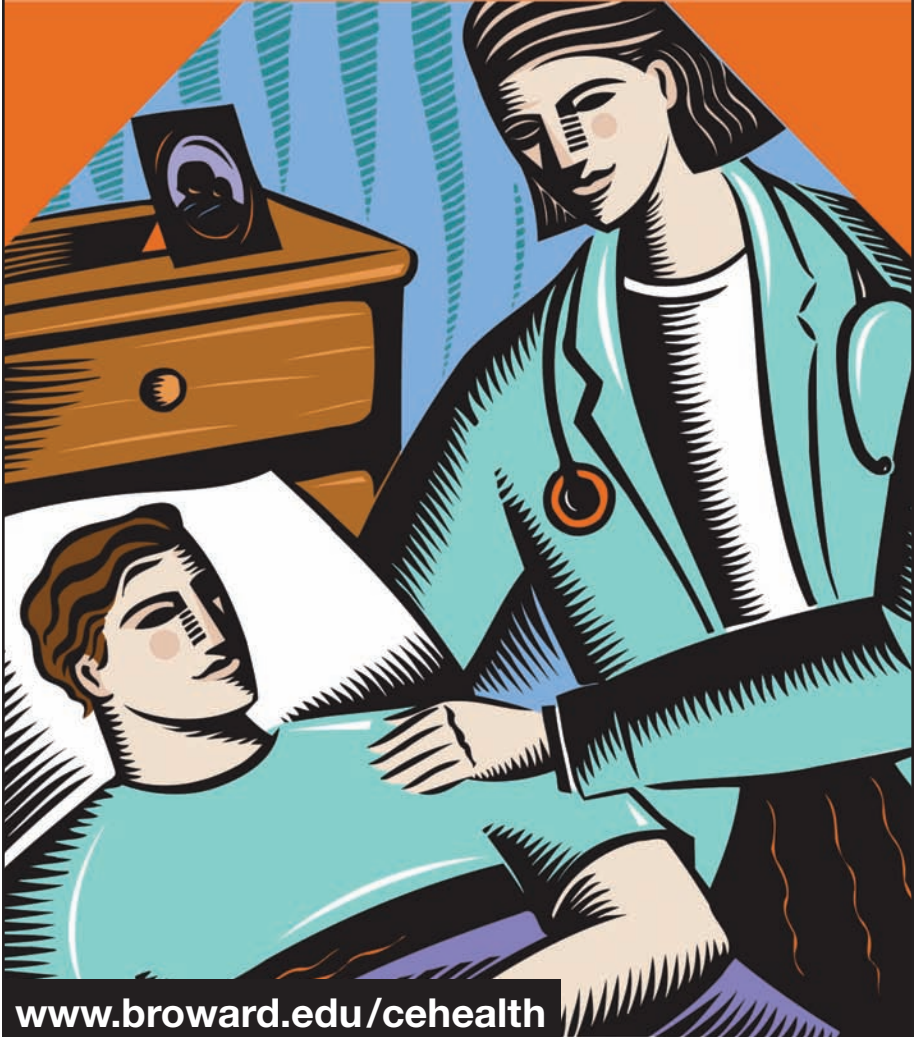

REGISTRATION AND PARKING INFORMATION

The Florida State Legislation mandates that those students who have NOT been a resident in the State of Florida for one (1) year may have to pay out-of-state fees for credit courses. Advance registration is preferred 10 days prior to all continuing education activities. Register UP TO TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE OFFERING. Registration after that time must be completed at any campus registration office in person. Priority will be given to early registrants. Early registration is encouraged to ensure a place in the class. Fees may vary according to the type of offering (unless indicated, meals and breaks are not included). Registration fees are payable at the time of registration.
