## 2. Summary of Proposal: (750 character maximum)

The purpose of this proposal is to introduce the new Baccalaureate Degree in Supervision and Management into the Broward College Programs of Study. The Bachelor of Applied Science Degree in Supervision and Management provides individuals who hold an Associate in Science (A.S.) or Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree the opportunity to further their education. Students completing this program will have the skills and knowledge required to become successful managers and leaders within public, private and non-profit organizations. The curriculum offers a practical approach to understanding supervision and management. A total of 13 new courses are being proposed for this degree.

## 3. Rationale for Proposal: (750 character maximum: use additional sheet if necessary)

The Bachelor of Applied Science Degree in Supervision and Management is proposed to address workforce demands in Region 22 that are currently unmet. Therefore, the State of Florida has identified this as a high demand-high need program initiative. A major aspect of the College's decision to pursue this program is the shortage of qualified graduates in the documented areas. Current projections indicate that by 2014 Broward County will require 8,355 workers in the Supervision and Management field.
