The Broward College financial aid committee will review and determine the amount of the award. Students must be US citizens or eligible noncitizens to be considered. Generally, you are an eligible noncitizen if you are:

- A permanent U.S. resident with a Permanent Resident Card (I-551)
- A conditional permanent resident (I-551C)
- The holder of an Arrival-Departure Record (I-94) from the Department of Homeland Security Showing any one of the following designations: "Refugee", "Asylum Granted", "Parolee" (I-94 Confirms that you were paroled for a minimum of one year and status has not expired), "Victim of human trafficking," T-Visa holder (T-1, T-2, T-3, etc.) or "Cuban-Haitian Entrant."

Scholarship requirements:

Students must be fully accepted to the applicable baccalaureate program. Preference will be given to students with high EFCs who are not receiving Pell Grant or any other forms of need-based aid. If eligible, students may reapply for renewal of the scholarship for a second year.

- Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid
- Must be enrolled as a full-time or part-time degree seeking student with a GPA of at least 2.0.
- Must submit 2 letters of recommendation with your application.
- An essay answering the questions below:

What are your plans after you receive your Bachelor's degree from Broward College?
Why should you receive this scholarship?

I agree that upon receiving funds from Broward College, I will abide by the criteria and rules for receiving the scholarship. The college may request additional information from students who are not United States citizens or do not have permanent resident cards (green cards). Broward College is required by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to determine the tax status of all student receiving payments from the college.
