



FFMT Scholarship: Florida Fund for Minority Teachers

Eligibility

Be a resident of the State of Florida.

Be: Black/American, Hispanic, Asian American/Pacific Islander, and American Indian/Alaskan Native.

Have earned 60 credit hours or an AA degree with a cumulative 2.5 GPA or higher.

GK Score Report with passing scores on each section (or passing CLAST scores prior to 7/1/02).

Be newly admitted into a teacher education program at FAU.

Be a junior and have not earned a baccalaureate degree in Education.

Have not exceeded 18 hours of upper division (3000-4000 level) education courses at the time of application. This includes currently enrolled FAU courses.

Scholarship Awards

The annual amount of the FFMT Scholarship is \$4,000. Awards are disbursed during the Fall and Spring semesters, in the amount of \$2,000 per semester. You may be eligible to receive the scholarship for up to two consecutive years.

Conditions

If you receive the scholarship, you must attend the Annual Conferences and maintain at least a 2.5 GPA & full time enrollment. Upon graduation, you are required to teach one year in a Florida public school for each year they received the scholarship. If you do not graduate within 2-3 years, or if you do not teach in a Florida public school, you will be required to repay the total amount of the scholarship received at an annual interest rate of 8%.
