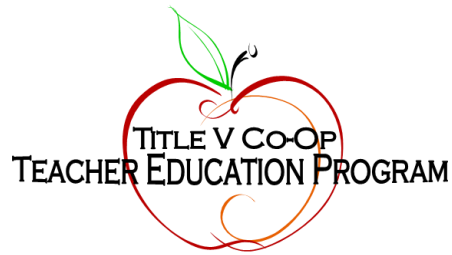


**Florida Teacher Certification Exam (FTCE)
General Knowledge Exam (GKE)**



What areas are covered in the General Knowledge Exam?

The GKE is a pass/fail exam with 4 subtests:

Math - 58% correct required to pass

Reading – 65% correct required to pass

English Language Skills – 65% correct required to pass

Essay - score of 6 out of 12.

Graded by two separate raters to give one combined score

Scores are provided immediately after testing on the computer, with the exception of the Essay which is sent within 30 days.

If you do not pass all subtests,
you would only need to retake those subtests that you did not pass.
Must allow 30 days in between retakes.

Effective immediately, all GKE tests must be taken on the computer, at a **Pearson VUE testing center**. There will be **NO** more pencil/paper test administered.

How much does it cost to register?	Fee
General Knowledge Test, First-Time Registration	\$130.00
General Knowledge Test, Retake Registration (one or more subtests)	\$150.00
