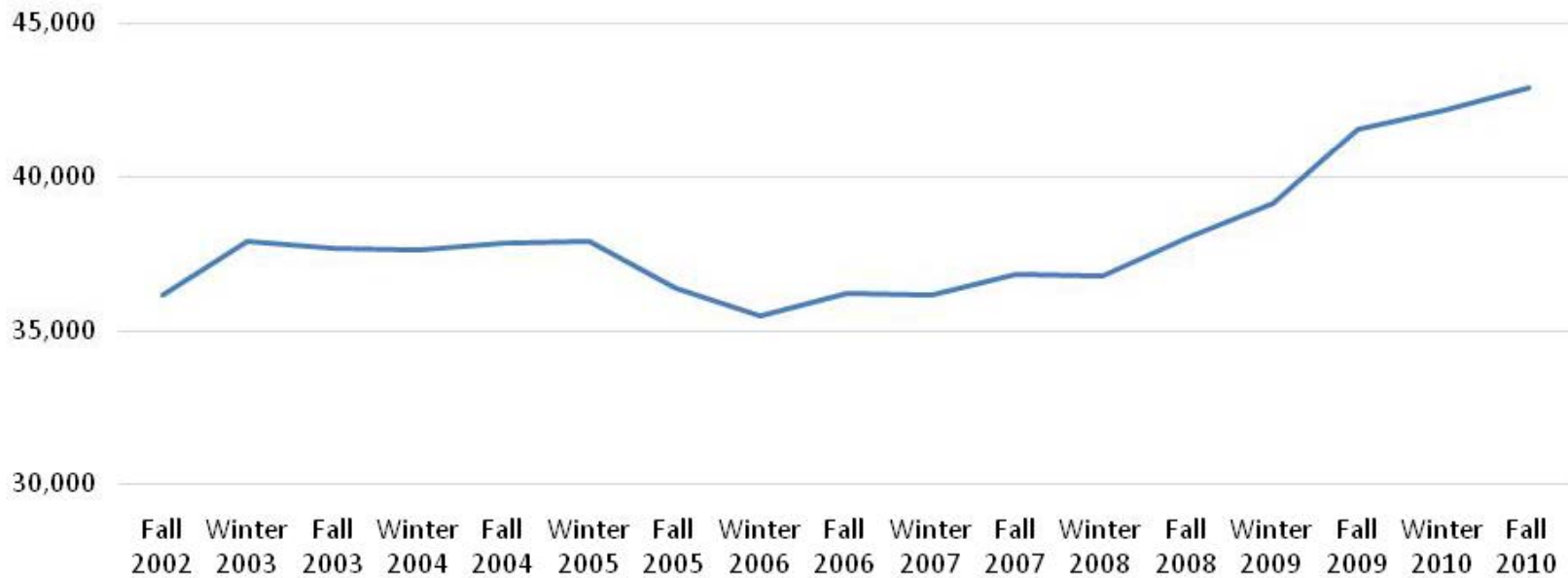

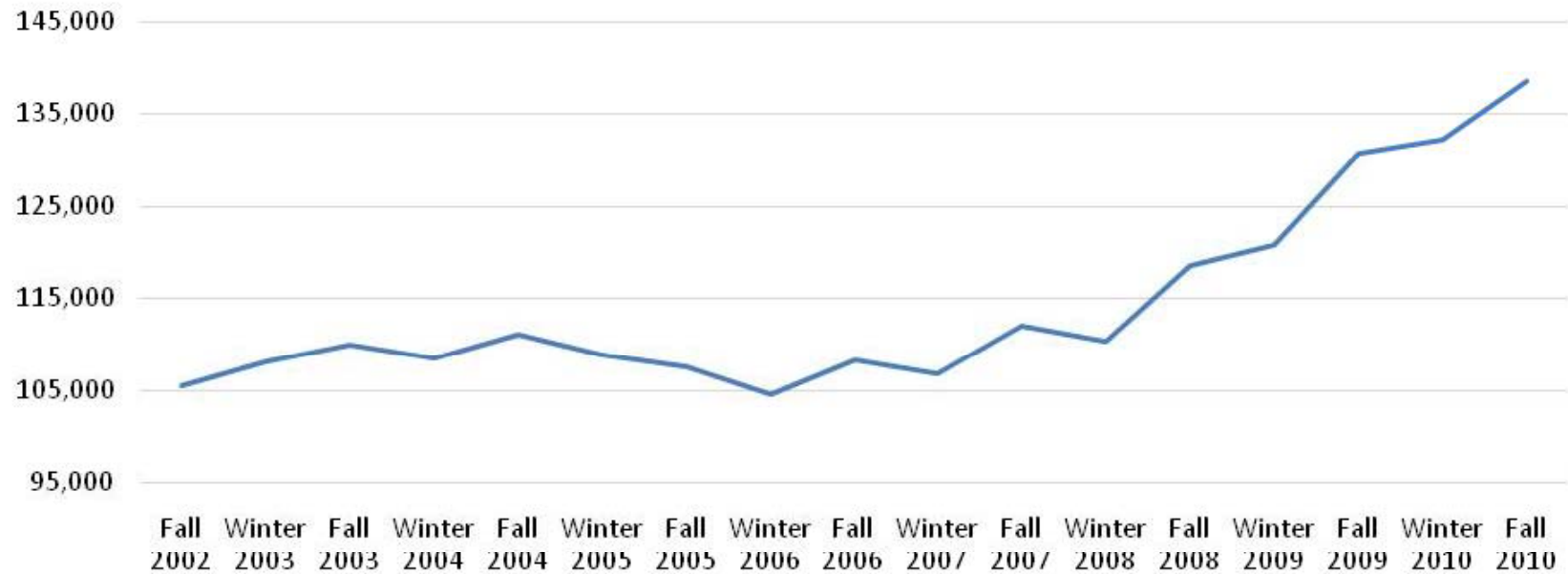
# Enrollment Trends (Fall and Winter Terms)

**Student Headcount 2002-2010**



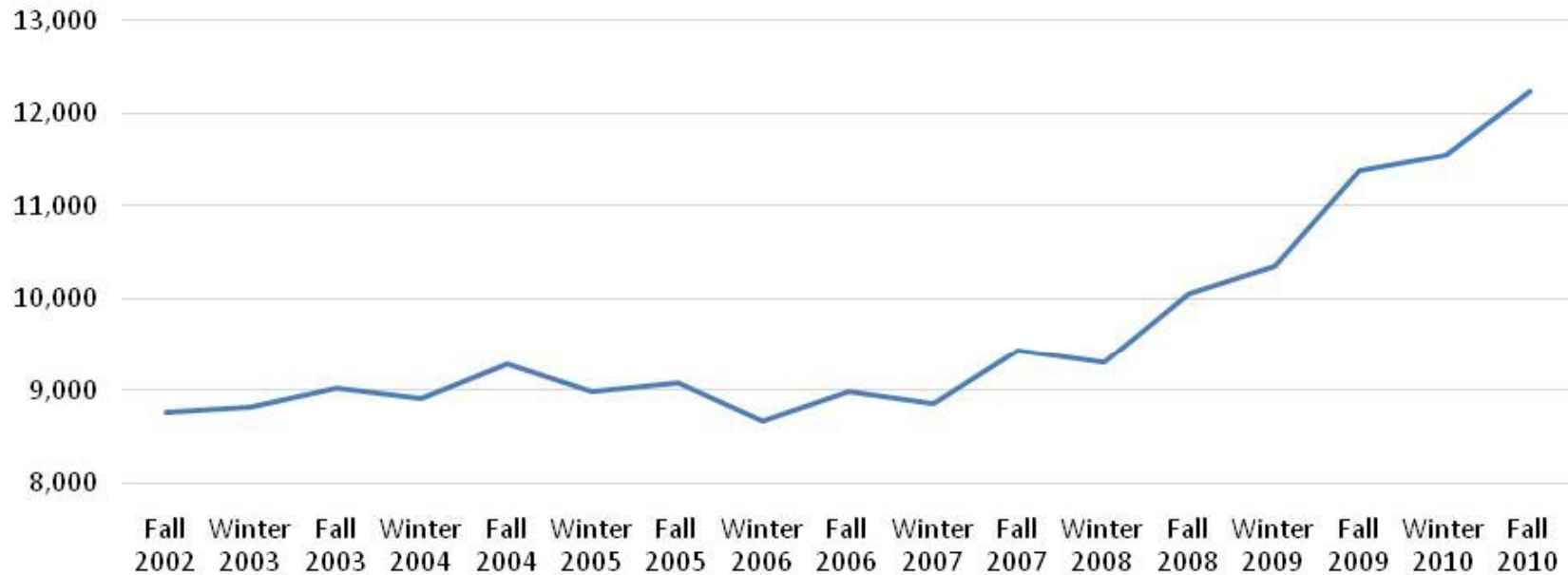
# Enrollment Trends (Fall and Winter Terms)
