INCOMING STUDENTS MUST HAVE:

- Have high school transcripts (if home schooled, they must present an official state acceptance certificate).
- Be a degree seeking student.
- Be a Florida resident (this includes proper DHS documentation)
- Be enrolled in at least 6 non-remedial classes.

Award Amounts

Florida Academic Scholars (FAS) will receive an award to cover 100% of tuition and applicable fees for Fall/Spring and Summer.

Florida Academic Scholarship Book (FASBK): \$300 for each semester, Fall & Spring only

Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS) will receive an award to cover 75% of tuition and applicable fees for Fall/Spring and Summer.

Scholarship Restrictions/Limitations

- A maximum of 45 semester hours may be funded in one academic year
- Gold Seal award (GSC/GSV) may only be used at postsecondary institutions that offer an applied technology diploma, technical degree education program (Associate in Science- AS or Associate in Applied Science- AAS). GSC recipients who earn a qualifying A.S. or A.A.S degree may be funded for a qualifying B.A or B.A.S bachelor's degree.
