The Kellogg Institute for the Training and Certification of Developmental Educators is the nation's oldest continuous advanced training program for developmental educators and learning skills specialists.

### **Program Element**

\*An intensive, four-week summer residence

\*A supervised practicum following residency and carried out at the participant's home campus.

The residency portion of the Institute includes four seminars on such topics as Assessment and Placement, Designing Learning Environments, Leadership and Academic Support Services Relating to Developmental Education, Outcomes Assessment and Program Evaluation. Each seminar is led by one or more recognized experts in the content area and is designed to meet the needs of the practicing developmental educator.

### **Topics**

\*Assessment and Placement

\*Designing learning environments

\*Leadership and academic support services relating to developmental education

\*Outcomes assessment and program evaluation

### **Application Process**

Submit a resume *and* brief essay by **September 15, 2006** to your campus provost through your Associate Dean and Academic Dean stating why you want to participate in the Kellogg Institute's Development Education program and how your participation will benefit the college.

### **Selection Process**

The President's Cabinet will review the applications, select the participants, and BCC will fund **two** developmental education faculty to attend the Kellogg Institute.

*Completion of this four-week program fulfills a faculty member's seven-year professional development requirement.*
