International Student Admission process:

New or Transfer Student

- Must complete an Associate Degree or 60 college level credits prior to applying for the Bachelor Degree Program.
- Review international admission requirements on the website at:

- If you have completed post-secondary work outside the United States you will be required to provide a commercial evaluation of all course work completed with your admission application. The evaluation must consist of a course-by-course evaluation and upper division course identification. The commercial evaluation companies recognized by Broward College are [Josef Silny & Associates, Inc.](#) and [World Education Services](#).

Current Student

- Must have completed an Associate Degree or 60 college level credits prior to applying for the Bachelor Degree Program.
- Complete a new international student application. (no additional fee required)

- Complete a new financial statement. (on application)
- Submit a new bank letter with a minimum balance of \$27,500.
