

William E. Greene Scholarship (WEGS) Application for International Study

The William E. Greene Scholarship for International Study is named after the founder of the BC Greene International Education Institute who served for 26 years as Director of International Education at BC. During that period Dr. Greene established numerous affiliations and agreements with foreign institutions which have established BC as a leader among U.S. colleges in international education. Scholarship funds are made available from the money generated through these programs.

This Scholarship will be awarded to students who are prepared to spend a full semester of study abroad at a location to be determined by the International Education Advisory Committee.

To be considered for the Greene scholarship, a student must:

- Submit a WEGS application to the Greene International Education Institute no later than **Friday October 2, 2009 for study abroad in spring 2010.**
- Submit a BC transcript with the WEGS application showing a minimum degree cumulative GPA of 3.0 and completion of twelve (12) credit hours in 1000 - and/or 2000- level courses, at BC at the time of application.
- Have successfully completed ENC 1101 with a minimum final course grade of C or better at the time of application, or before.
- Be an AA, AS or AAS degree-seeking student.
- Be 18 years of age or older by the time of departure.
- Include with the WEGS application two faculty recommendations in letter form.
- Be available for a personal interview with the International Education Advisory Committee. No student will be selected who has not been personally interviewed by the committee.
- Affirm that he/she has read the ***WEGS Guidelines and Criteria.***
- Agree to enroll in a full schedule (12-15 semester hours) of classes at the BC affiliate program in Singapore, Guayaquil or Spain during the spring term of 2010.
- Agree to participate in activities to support the International Education programs at Broward College during the first term after returning as designated by the International Education Advisory Committee (see ***WEGS Guidelines and Criteria.***)
