COURSE DESCRIPTION: Using a combination of lecture and case studies taken from actual incidents, this 4 hour workshop will provide instructors with tools to appropriately address disruptive behavior. Participants will be provided with skills to prevent disruptive behaviors, to react to them, and tips on how to enhance their own campus procedures to address abhorrent behaviors.

COURSE OBJECTIVES: At the end of this program, students will:

- Gain a perspective on trends in behaviors on higher education campuses
- Gain a perspective on the realities of campus responses to incidents of classroom disruption
- Be able to utilize pedagogical methods and teaching strategies to reduce the probability of disruptive behaviors
- Be able to develop and/or utilize individualized syllabus statements for class management
- Be able to appropriately respond to

disruptive behaviors in and out of the classroom

- Be able to assist their home campuses in policy development in the area of classroom management
