**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:** Applicants for Arson Investigator Certification must successfully complete (4) required courses of study based upon minimum standards designated by the state in accordance with NFPA Standard 1033, FL Statutes - Chapter 633, and the State Fire Marshal Rules - Chapter 69A-37, FL Administrative Code. Satisfactory course completion is one of the eligibility requirements to sit for the State Certification Examination administered by the Bureau of Fire Standards and Training.

All courses provide (40) contact hours in a non-traditional format. Participants earn three (3) Credits per course, which may be applied as elective credits in the Fire Science Program. The course of study is designed to improve agency response to the arson problem by improving the technical competencies of investigation personnel, and the effectiveness of subsequent criminal prosecution.

**All students must be registered with the State of Florida Fire College and have a State Student I.D. Number for admission to the program. If you do not have a Student I.D. from the state, one may be obtained at the State's web site: [www.floridastatefirecollege.org](http://www.floridastatefirecollege.org).**
