**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:** Fire Officer 2 (FO 2) Certification is based upon minimum standards designated by the state, in accordance with NFPA Standard 1021 (Professional Qualifications for Fire Officer). The FO 2 program at Broward College includes eight (8) credit courses, consistent with education requirements established by the Bureau of Fire Standards and Training.

All courses provide (40) contact hours plus an (8) hour equivalent project requirement in a condensed time frame, over a five to seven week period. Regular grades and college credits are earned for each course. The program is designed to prepare firefighters for promotion to Command Level Officer or to improve the effectiveness of personnel already serving in this capacity. Many area Fire Departments are considering FO 2 certification as a requirement for promotion to this level. Students completing the program should submit their credentials to the State of Florida for certification as a Fire Officer 2 as soon as they finish. There currently is no state exam for this certification.

**All students must be registered with the State of Florida Fire College and have a State Student I.D. Number for admission to the program. If you do not have a Student I.D. from the state, one may be obtained at the State’s web site:** [www.floridastatefirecollege.org](http://www.floridastatefirecollege.org).
