



# ANNOUNCEMENT

## POLICE ACADEMY

The **XXX**nd Session of the Broward County Police Academy will begin with a six-hour **Orientation** on **XXX** and full-time classes commencing on **XXX** and continuing through **XXX**. The hours will be from 7:45 AM until 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This Police Academy meets all basic training requirements of the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission (to include "Patrol Operations", simulated police situations evaluated by Field Training officers). Upon satisfactory completion, students will be eligible to take the CJSTC certification examination. Students must pass the CJSTC examination to qualify for certification, as prescribed in Chapter 943.17(1), F. S.

### ELIGIBILITY:

Law Enforcement agencies are invited to participate by enrolling personnel who meet the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Qualifications established under Chapter 943.13, F. S. Persons selected to attend the Broward County Police Academy must have successfully completed the following entrance requirements:

- 1 Criminal Justice Basic Abilities Test (C.J.B.A.T.)
- 2 I.P.S. Motor-skills test (**good for six months**)
- 3 I.P.S. Swimming test (good indefinitely)
- 4 Background investigation
- 5 Medical (including drug screen)
- 6 Physical Fitness Assessment (CJSTC – 75B)
- 7 Psychological Evaluation
- 8 Criminal History check from fingerprints

Trainees who attend this session through a Certificate of Sponsorship from an agency must present proof of current major medical insurance protection, or purchase student accident insurance for the term of the academy.

### FEES:

The cost per trainee is **\$3,350.00, payable to Broward College/IPS**. Agencies will be billed by the Academy. **Sponsored** trainees must submit payment in full at Orientation. **Make check payable to B.C./I.P.S.**

### REGISTRATION:

Class size is limited to forty four (**44**) students, admitted in order of receipt of notification from the employing agency.

**ORIENTATION:** It is mandatory that all applicants attend this orientation, scheduled for **XXX** at **8AM** for approximately six hours. No other orientation session is scheduled for this academy. Applicants **must** dress in business attire.

**EQUIPMENT:** Trainees must furnish their handgun and belt accessories provided or approved by the employing agency.

Sponsored trainees should provide handgun and belt accessories of leather or nylon type consisting of belt, holster (applicable to the handgun), double loading device case, handcuff case and belt keepers. The handgun **must** be approved by the academy Range master for the standard police caliber of 38 special, 9mm, 40 S & W, or 45 auto.
