I. Course Overview:

Upon successful completion of this course, the students should be able to demonstrate significant learning which is the result of career-related work experience.

II. Specific Learning Outcomes:

Students are expected to:

- 1.1 Develop two learning objectives approved by the job supervisor and campus coordinator.
- 1.2 Keep a daily activity journal that identifies the tasks as well as the learning acquired from these tasks.
- 1.3 Present thorough research of their major areas of career interest and alternatives within that area.
- 1.4 Provide an employer evaluation of work habits and of progress towards meeting the learning objectives (item #1) during the term.
- 1.5 Summarize the learning that has been acquired as a result of the co-op experience each term. Upon the direction of the Co-op Coordinator the use of a work journal may be required.
