I. Course Overview:

Upon successful completion of this course, the students should be able to synthesize their experience of living and studying in a foreign country with specific knowledge of the country's art history and culture gained through participation in program-sponsored field trips to museums, galleries, important architecture and other activities related to the study of art.

NOTE: Course typically includes:

1. Predeparture Classes
2. Textbooks or Reading Lists
3. Field Trips
4. Post-Trip Classes
5. Course Project, Written Paper or Exam as Designated by the Instructor

Special Student Projects: (type projects at the paragraph mark below)

1. A written report on museum visits, field trips and excursions as specified by the instructor.
2. A portfolio of sketches and/or a collection of slides, printed material, acquisition of native crafts, etc. may be recommended to support the written report or as a course project.
3. Completion of a program evaluation at the end of the term. This evaluation will cover instructors, courses, field trips, living quarters, etc. Students will submit this evaluation personally to the BCC faculty member responsible for the program.
