### **Course Overview:**

The course provides **high beginning-level** ESL students with tools that can greatly help them develop their speaking and listening skills. Students study information about pronunciation, practice sounds in the Lab, and apply it when they speak. They engage in student-centered collaborative activities in the classroom providing maximum opportunities to listen and speak.

### **Unit 1** Sound System

#### **General Outcome:**

- 1.3** Associate each vowel sound with a key word.
- 1.4** Distinguish and pronounce consonant sounds.
- 1.5** Pronounce consonants in words so that the words are comprehensible.

**2.0 The student shall:** understand topics and main ideas when listening to extended speech.
