### **Unit 1. Travel Preparation and Introductory Survey**

Upon successful completion of this unit, the students should be able to:

- 1.1 Chronicle the essential historical/cultural features of the sites to be visited and/or topics to be emphasized.
- 1.2 Locate study-abroad sites geographically and relate them historically.
- 1.3 Exhibit familiarity with the study-abroad itinerary and practical travel requirements.

## Unit 2. Visit to Study-Abroad Site(s)

### General Outcome:

2.0 The students should be able to present evidence of daily participation in course related activities during the study-abroad experience.

### Specific Learning Outcomes:

Upon successful completion of this unit, the students should be able to:

2.1 Explain how each site visited represents essential features of the history and culture under consideration.

2.2 Cite or describe specific artifacts which exemplify the essential features cited.

### Unit 3. Post-Travel Review

3.0 The students should be able to demonstrate greater understanding of the history and culture of the study-abroad sites and knowledge of the practical requirements for travel and study abroad.

- 3.2 Cite or describe specific artifacts which exemplify sites visited.
- 3.3 Recount the impact of direct exposure to the actual study-abroad experience overseas.
- 3.4 Demonstrate a greater familiarity with overseas travel procedures.
- 3.5 Explain a deeper knowledge of the history and culture of the study-abroad topics and sites through the mechanisms provided for evaluation.
