Incident Location:

Willis Holcombe Center FAU Ground Parking Lot & Building 31

Dates of Occurrences:

- Tuesday, November 15, 2016 at 11:57 AM
- Wednesday, November 16, 2016 at 11:02 AM
- Friday, November 18, 2016 between the hours of 3:35 AM and 4:20 AM
- Sunday, November 20, 2016 at 4:09 AM

Incident Details:

- Four separate incidents involving theft and vandalism of personal property.
- The **first incident** (Tuesday, November 15, 2016 at 11:57 AM) and **second incident** (Wednesday, November 16, 2016 at 11:02AM) appeared to have been conducted by the same suspect in the same methods. In both instances, the individual used bolt cutters to remove the locks/chains from the bicycles and then proceeded to ride off. The suspect was seen coming from the parking garage area and then riding off toward the courthouse in both incidents. Suspect is described as a black male, 185-220 pounds, 5'8" – 5'10".

- The **third** incident occurred on Friday, November 18, 2016 between the hours of 3:35 AM and 4:20 AM and involved the vandalism/break-in of 3 separate vehicles in the FAU ground lot of WHC. It was reported that there were 2 suspects looking in vehicles between 3:35 AM and 3:45 AM who may have then proceeded to break into the vehicles.
- The **fourth** incident occurred on Sunday, November 20, 2016 at 4:09 AM and involved a vehicle being broken into and vandalized in the FAU ground lot of WHC. There is believed to have been 2 suspects who approached the lot from the parking garage.
- The City of Fort Lauderdale Police Department and Broward College's Department of Safety, Security, & Emergency Preparedness are investigating these reported crimes.

Prevention Tips:

Members of the College community are urged to take normal safety precautions such as parking their vehicles in well-lit and well-travelled areas and reporting suspicious persons and activity to Campus Safety. Always close your windows, lock your vehicle, and take your keys.
