Motor Vehicle Theft

Incident Location:

South Campus Parking Lot A & Parking Lot B

Date of Occurrence/s:

Tuesday, January 17, 2017 between the hours of 8:45 PM and 9:30 PM
Wednesday, January 25, 2017 between the hours of 3:00 PM and 9:00 PM

Incident Details:

- Two individuals reported motor vehicle thefts which occurred on separate dates. The first occurred approximately between 8:45 PM and 9:30 PM on Tuesday, January 17, 2017 within Parking Lot B at South Campus. The second occurred approximately between the hours of 3:00 PM and 9:00 PM on Wednesday, January 25, 2017 within Parking Lot A at South Campus.
- The victims reported that they parked their vehicles and upon returning discovered they had been stolen.
- In both instances the vehicles have been described as sixth generation Honda Civics (2000-2005).
- The Pembroke Pines Police Department and Broward College's Department of Safety, Security, & Emergency Preparedness are investigating these reported crimes.

Prevention Tips:

Members of the College community are urged to take normal safety precautions such as parking their vehicles in well-lit and well-travelled areas and reporting suspicious persons and activity to Campus Safety. Always close your windows, lock your vehicle, and take your keys.
