ATTEMPTED KIDNAPPING

IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE JEANNE CLERY DISCLOSURE OF CAMPUS SECURITY POLICY AND CRIME STATISTICS ACT OF 1998, THIS BULLETIN IS POSTED TO ADVISE YOU OF AN INCIDENT THAT CONCERNS THE SAFETY OF THE COLLEGE COMMUNITY. PLEASE TAKE ALL NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS.

Incident Location:

Nova Southeastern University (NSU)- 3600 College Avenue (Across the street from Nova's Goodwin Residence Hall)

Date of Occurrence/s:

Monday September 25, 2017 at approximately 10:00PM

Incident Details:

An NSU Resident student reported that while walking southbound on the east side of College Avenue a black four door sedan (unknown make/model/year) traveling north bound approached the student. One of three males inside the vehicle began talking to the student and then exited vehicle and continued talking to the student. While the suspect approached the student he then put his hand around the student's arm. NSU student refused suspect's request to get into the vehicle and broke his grip, whereupon the suspect pushed the student to the ground.

The NSU student describes the suspect as: 6 ft. tall white male with a tan complexion, black hair wearing a black shirt, thin build and approximately 20 years old.

Prevention Tips:

- When possible, avoid walking alone. Walk with a friend or walk in well-traveled and well-lit areas. In addition, if you do not have someone to walk with you feel free to use our Safety Escort Program by calling 954-201-**HELP** (4357)
- Be aware of people around you. When you are walking, stay alert and tuned into your surroundings.
- Walk with confidence; show that you are aware and in control.
- If you are being followed, go to the nearest business or residence for help.
- If you are harassed by the occupants of a car, turn and walk in the other direction. The driver will have to turn around to follow you.
