



Admissions Requirements

Bachelor of Applied Science in Supervision and Management

GENERAL ADMISSION STATEMENT

- Current Broward College students must complete a Bachelor of Applied Science supplemental program application
- Returning Broward College students or graduates must complete a re-entry application in person or online (www.broward.edu) and a Bachelor of Applied Science supplemental program application
- New students must complete an online Broward College admissions application (www.broward.edu), pay the \$35 application fee and complete a Bachelor of Applied Science supplemental application. Transfer applicants must submit official transcript(s) from all previously attended postsecondary institutions
- International Students must be admitted into the college. See international admissions requirements listed in the Broward College catalog or contact the District International Admissions office at the Willis Holcombe Center, 225 E. Las Olas Blvd. Ft. Lauderdale, FL 33301

PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The following are required to be provisionally admitted into the program;

- An Associate in Science, an Associate in Applied Science, or an Associate in Arts degree from a regionally accredited institution or 60 college credits approved by the program dean
- A Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale in all post-secondary coursework
- Completion of all college preparatory coursework and a minimum of 15 college credits of transferable general education coursework

Prior to registering for any classes, students **must** meet with the program advisor to evaluate all post-secondary transcripts and determine an individual educational plan.

Final acceptance into the Bachelor of Applied Science in Supervision and Management must be approved by the program dean based on successful completion of the above requirements and the student's individual education plan.
