Participation criteria

- 3.0 cumulative and previous term GPA for duration of program
- 15 college credits completed before fall 2008
- Enrolled as a full-time BCC student during the two terms of Competitive Edge participation
- Ability to participate in the program for the entire academic year
- Available to board a flight to Tallahassee in March 2009

Competitive Edge students receive:

- A \$1,000 scholarship (\$500 per term), pending the availability of funds
- An opportunity to learn about leadership and organizational dynamics
- An opportunity to travel, make friends, and network with senior college administrators and Florida State legislators
- *A Competitive Edge on life . . .*

Competitive Edge is designed to give participants the opportunity to observe leadership in action. Students develop an ethical, value-based leadership style for future education, organizational and community leadership roles.

Competitive Edge responsibilities

- Complete a three-credit leadership class in the fall term
- Complete 20 hours of shadowing a member of the BCC President's Cabinet by January 31, 2009
- Serve on a collegewide committee for the duration of the Competitive Edge program
- Travel to Tallahassee (at the college's expense) for one week in March 2009 to shadow a Florida State legislator and view the legislative process
- Attend monthly Competitive Edge meetings
- Represent the college at other events

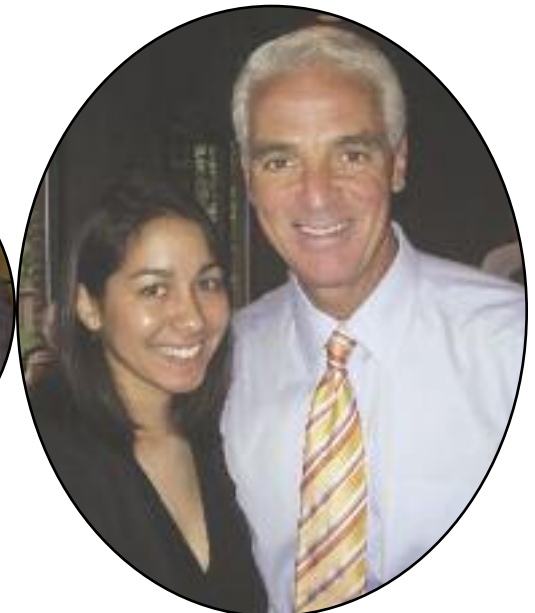
