International Student Admission Requirements

Dear Student:

Welcome to Broward Community College. We are delighted you have decided to apply for admission. Please read the following instructions carefully, as it will assist you in filling out the application correctly.

All of the Broward Community College International Student Forms, including the documentation of your ability to read, write, speak and understand English and copies of your complete academic record, must be submitted to the College Registrar before any admission decision will be considered. No action will be taken until you have submitted the following records.

1. Completed **student application** for admission to Broward Community College, signed and dated.
2. A **written history** (listing) of your educational training from your first year in school through the highest level completed on the front of this application.
3. If English is your second language, you must have the **TOEFL** with a minimum score of 500 on a paper-based test, a minimum score of 173 on a computer-based test, or a minimum score of 61 on the Internet-based test. If you are in the U.S., you may take an English Placement Test along with a writing sample, which is given at BCC in place of the TOEFL. **An official copy of the results of your English test must be attached or on file in the International Admissions Office at the Downtown Center before your application for admission will be considered.**
4. **Confidential Financial Statement Form with a signature** from your sponsor, along with a bank letter showing U.S. funds available (see page 3). A minimum of US\$18,000 per year is required.
5. **Copies of all of your educational records** through the highest level completed. If secondary school is your highest level completed, please attach a copy of your diploma or its equivalent (GED), and/or four academic passes in the GCE, CXC, BGSE or HKCE exams for the British system. University records **must** be translated into English by an official translation service. High school documents do not have to be translated, with the exception of Asian, Hebrew or Arabic.
6. **A US\$75.00 non-refundable check or money order** application fee.
7. We require evidence of **health insurance**. **AFTER ADMISSION** you may either purchase health insurance through BCC's approved insurance vendor or, if using another insurance company, you must provide us with a compliance form to verify equal coverage.

The International Admissions Office will review **only the complete** International Student Applications for Admissions each Friday. The decision will be mailed to the student.

INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER STUDENTS

When transferring from any other educational institution to Broward Community College, the requirements for admission are that official copies of ALL previous education transcripts MUST be submitted in addition to the application, the US\$75.00 application fee, a copy of your I-20 form from the previous school you attended, and all other requirements stated above.

Transferring students are **provisionally** accepted until their transcripts are received and their full-time status and grade point average of 2.0 are verified. Students must maintain full-time status and a grade point average of 2.0 or they will be administratively withdrawn from Broward Community College. When courses have been completed at BCC, you must transfer within sixty days to another college or return to your country. If you fail to do this, you will be out of status with the United States.

If you have completed post-secondary work outside the U.S., you will be required to have a commercial evaluation completed within 30 days of your first day of class by a commercial evaluation company recognized at BCC.

ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

International Students must meet all of the following academic regulations and standards of performance to remain enrolled in Broward Community College.

1. International students must register as a **"full-time student" in a minimum of 12 semester hours during the Fall and Winter terms.** If the Summer term is your first term, you must also register for a minimum of 12 semester hours in that term.
2. International students must make satisfactory progress toward their degree objective each term. (You must maintain a "C" average, 2.0).
3. International students must enroll continuously in appropriate English language courses as prescribed by the English Department until all English requirements for the degree are completed.

International students who do not meet all the above academic regulations and standards of performance for any term will not be permitted to attend the following term. They will be administratively withdrawn by the college and a 100 percent refund will be given to the student for any fees paid for the term following the violation of the academic regulations and the standards of performance.

FEES

Fees for non-Florida students who enroll at BCC are \$242.05 per semester hour credit and must be paid in full at the time of registration. College regulations prohibit installment (partial) payments or billing of individual student fees. Special fees are charged in certain courses to cover the use of special supplies, materials, equipment or facilities. The cost of books and supplies averages \$350.00 per term. The approximate cost for 12 months at Broward Community College is \$18,000 (tuition, fees, books, transportation, housing and personal expenses). Please be aware that fees may increase without notice by the Board of Trustees. **We do not provide on-campus housing.**
