

Dear Students,

Because of severe cutbacks in funding, the County Library system will close all county libraries on Sundays beginning October 4th. This includes the North Regional Library.

However, the Learning Resources Center will remain open on Sundays from 1:00pm to 5:00pm. Services will be limited to the LRC area on the first floor (the Writing Center, the Language Lab, the Open Lab, and the A & P lab). Tutoring services will also be available.

Because we are trying to stay opened while the rest of the library is closed, we are asking you to abide by the following rules.

1. Only currently enrolled students with ID's will be allowed to enter the library. Children, friends, or relatives will not be allowed to enter.
2. You must show your BC Identity Card to gain access to the LRC. Library areas other than the LRC will be roped off. You must stay within the LRC area.
3. You will not have access to the Reference Area, Periodicals Section, book holdings, or any other areas or services offered by the library, including the use of the NRL's copiers.
4. You will not be able to check out NRL materials and books; however, you will be able to check out Learning Resources materials.

Please help us keep the Learning Resources Center on North Campus open on Sundays by abiding by these rules.
