Parking And Traffic Rules*

- ◆ Parking decals/permits are required
 - ◆ “Head-in” parking only
 - ◆ **No “Back-in” parking**
 - ◆ **No parking** in reserved areas
 - ◆ **No parking** on grass (except in designated parking areas)
 - ◆ **No parking** in driveways, fire lanes, access aisles
 - ◆ Curbside parking in **non-yellow** areas only
 - ◆ No student parking in “Visitor” spaces
 - ◆ Vehicle speed limit is 10 mph

Broward College North Campus Safety is committed to maintaining a safe and secure learning and working environment, to staff development and training, and to public awareness of safety issues.

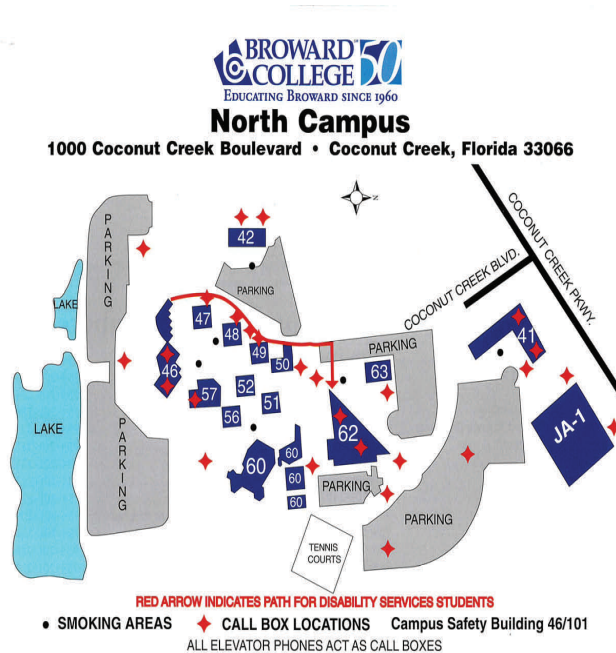
The **Campus Safety Program** partnering with the Broward Sheriff's Office strengthens Broward College's deep commitment to protecting and serving its citizens. A partnership was formed to address problems and fight crime in an environment of trust, professional pride, personal responsibility, integrity and service. To that end, one full-time Broward Sheriff's Deputy is assigned to provide specialized police services to the campus community.



General Guidelines

- ◆ Travel with a buddy when possible
- ◆ Report all suspicious persons / incidents to Campus Safety
- ◆ Walk in well-lit areas
- ◆ Don't carry large amounts of cash
- ◆ Keep personal belongings with you at all times
- ◆ Keep vehicles locked at all times
- ◆ Do not bring animals on campus
- ◆ Keep any valuables in your vehicle out of view
- ◆ Report all thefts, loss, injuries, and accidents to Campus Safety
- ◆ Carry a cell phone and program the after-hours number

For your safety ...

◆ **Emergency call boxes:** have been installed at numerous locations on the North Campus grounds. In the parking areas, they appear as yellow or blue, long-circular shaped boxes mounted on poles topped with solar panels. These operate like “push to talk” radios. To operate the box, simply open it and push the **BLACK** button to talk and release to listen. In buildings, the call boxes operate like a speaker phone. Operate the box by pushing the **RED** button. The box automatically connects to a campus safety officer.



◆ **An after-hours emergency phone number:** has been established that you may dial from any phone, any where, and be directly connected to a Campus Safety Officer 24 hours a day 365 days a year.

General Guidelines (continued)

- ◆ Bicycles may only be ridden on campus roadways
- ◆ Bicycles may not be ridden on campus sidewalks
- ◆ Always lock bicycles in a designated bike rack
- ◆ All motorized scooters, electric / gas go peds, seat scooters, or other mechanically-powered vehicles are prohibited, except when used by a disabled person as a mobility-assistance device
- ◆ Roller blading, roller skating, and skateboarding are not permitted on campus
- ◆ **NEVER** bring a weapon of any kind on to the campus grounds or parking areas
- ◆ Keep cool. Don't become a threat to the safety of others - Talk it out
- ◆ When in doubt, call Campus Safety. Please don't hesitate to call Campus Safety for anything that just doesn't seem right. Call right away!
- ◆ Safety is everyone's responsibility
